

















O.L. Dever, who helped build Meeker Park Lodge in 1935 and was its original owner, killed this deer that now overlooks the lodge's living room.




Classmate Profiles: Roger Lanning

 EOD Group Two at Little Creek VA.








Classmate Profile: Jerry Burd






Classmate Profiles: Connie Bernhardt





- Lost Larry in 2004... He is always in our hearts. Love never dies.















- We returned to Loveland after 26 years in Washington state.


