

SUGGESTIONS OF WHAT TO SUBMIT FOR THE PRESENTATION

The format for each person will be a PowerPoint slide. (See examples below.) We would like 3-6 bullets of text and 3-7 color or black-and-white pictures. Also, if you have photos of Loveland, especially of those of circa 1968, we can use those also. Here are some examples of what you might include in your 3-5 bullets...

1. Where have you been?
2. What have you been doing since graduation? Hobbies? Occupations?
3. Where are you living now and why? What do you spend your time doing?
4. Did you serve in the military? Details?
5. What is your current status? Retired? Working? Family?
6. What interesting messages would you like to share?
7. Did you own an interesting business? Details?
8. Have you traveled to some interesting places? Why? Where? Discoveries?
9. Did you live in any interesting places? Where? What took you there?
10. What is the most exciting or notable thing you have ever done?
