The website includes additional concepts of the plaza, and also provides you with the opportunity to make an online donation. All donations are appreciated. We are classified as a nonprofit 501c3 so all donations of \$250.00 or more will be provided with a receipt. We are currently working in cooperation with the City of Loveland to erect a sign at the future location of our plaza. That in itself is an accomplishment. Since the announcement of the plaza on Veteran's Day a lot has happened. We've called on many businesses and met a lot of people in the process. We are having a lot of success and a general feeling that there are a lot of people out there that are behind this project. For instance, the website was developed in one afternoon during a call on a potential donor! We've been receiving donations both from the general public and the LHS Alumni.
